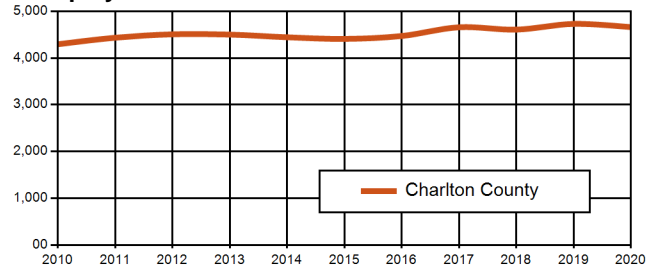

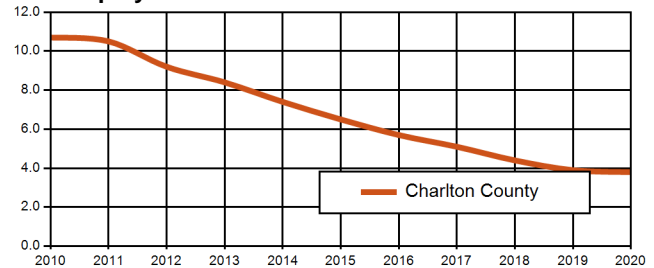

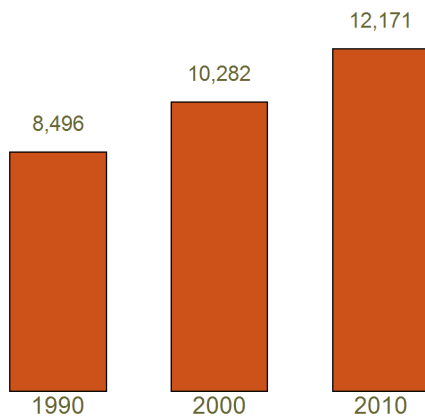

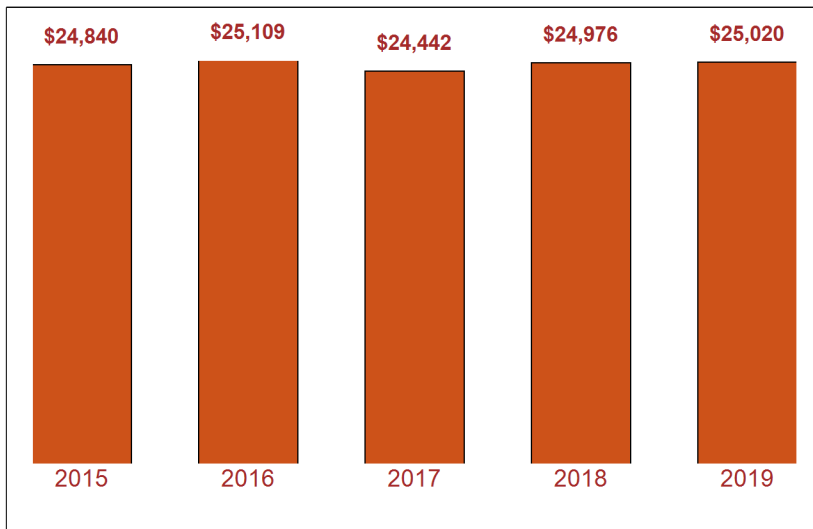

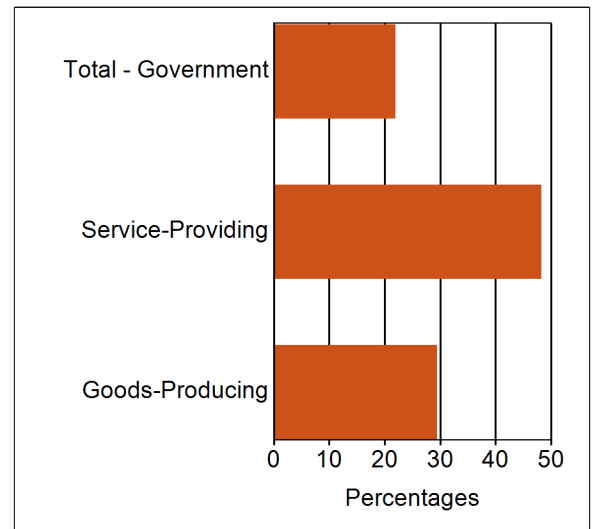
Charlton Per Capita Income
