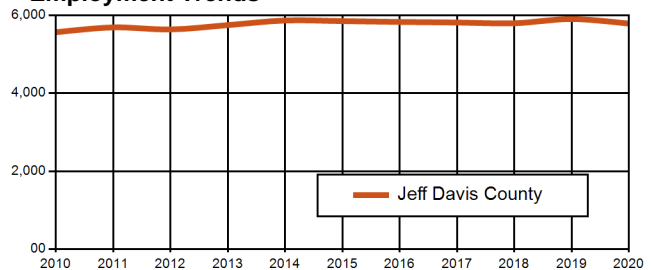

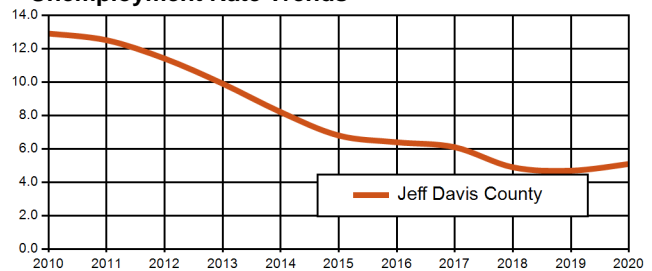

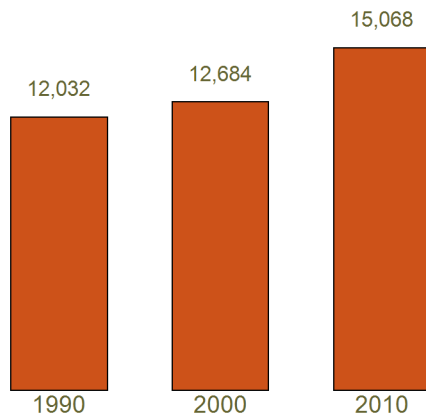
Unemployment Rate Trends

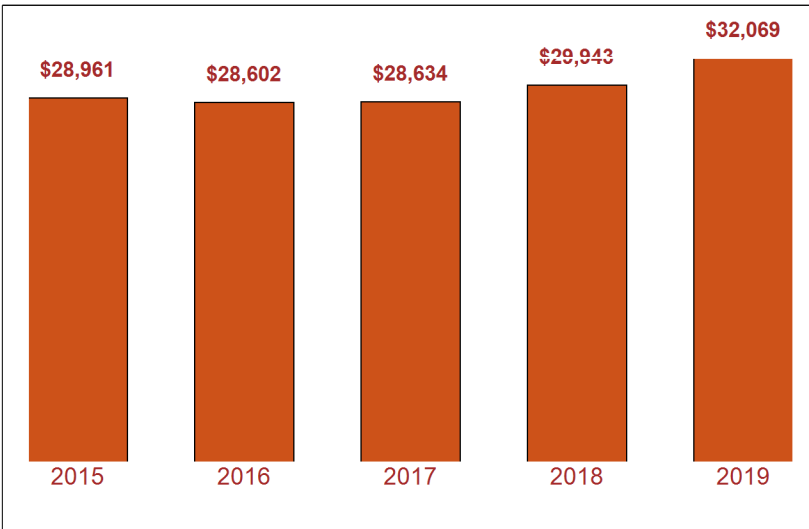

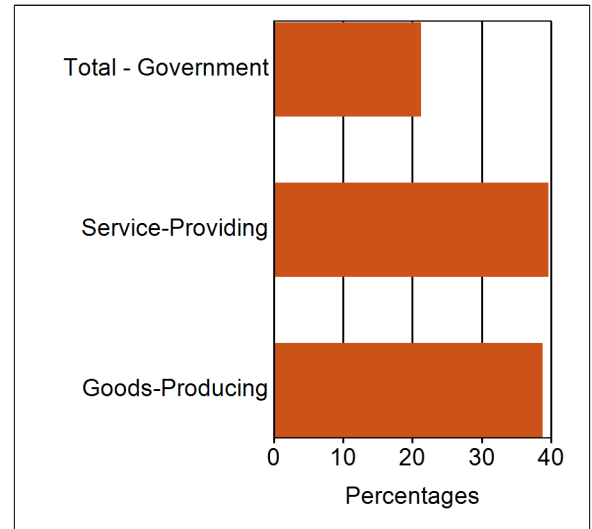
