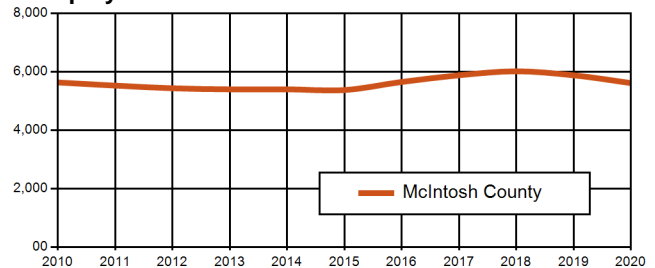

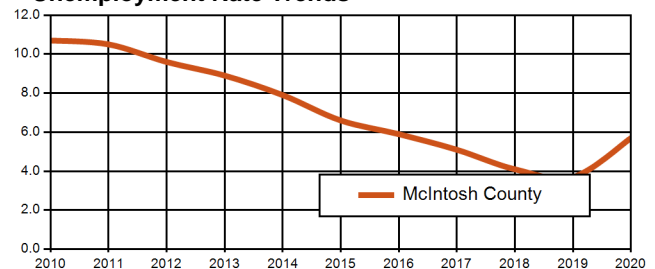

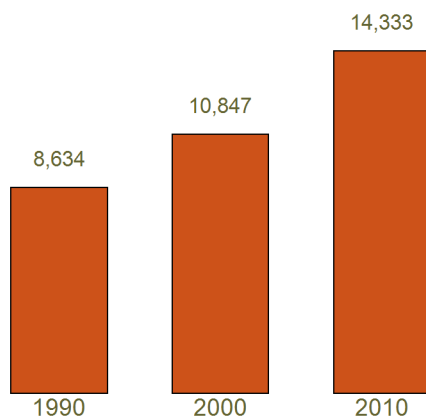

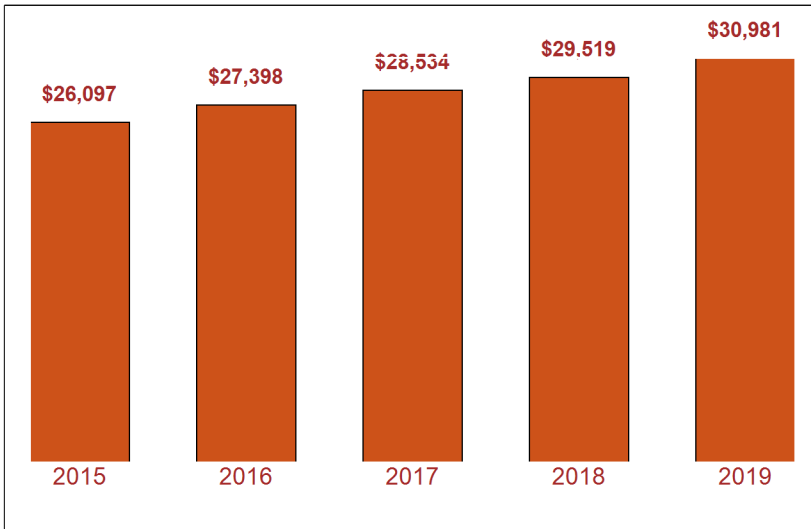

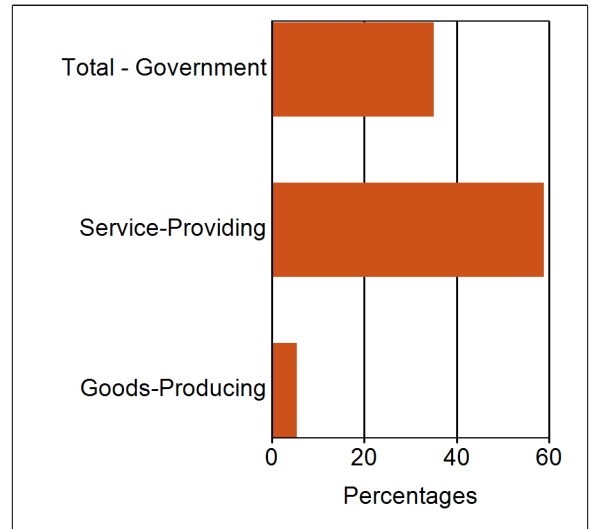
McIntosh Per Capita Income
