## **OSHA 10-Hour General Industry**

The 10-hour training program is primarily intended for entry level workers. Training is intended to cover an overview of the hazards a worker may encounter on a job site and emphasizes hazard identification, avoidance, control and prevention.

- Mandatory Topics (6 Hours)
  - o Introduction to OSHA
  - o Walking and Working Surfaces, Including Fall Protection
  - o Exit Routes, Emergency Action Plans, Fire Preventioin Plans, and Fire Protection
  - o Electrical
  - Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)
  - Hazard Communication
- Electives (2 Hours at least two topics and lasting at least 1/2-hour each)
  - o Hazardous Materials
  - Materials Handling
  - Maching Guarding
  - Introduction to Industrial Hygiene
  - o Bloodborne Pathogens
  - o Ergonomics
  - Safety and Healther Program
  - o Fall Protection
- Optional (2 Hours)
  - Teach other general industry hazards or policies and/or expand on the mandatory or elective topics. The minimum length of any topic is 1/2-hour.
