/ CARES Funds Awarded for Spring Semester 2022

Coastal Pines Technical College has been awarded additional Coronavirus grant funds that are available through the Higher Education Emergency Relief Funds (HEERF). These funds allow colleges to distribute grants to students to cover expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to COVID-19, to assist in covering any component

of a student's cost of attendance, and to assist with emergency costs that arise due to the coronavirus, such as tuition, food, housing, healthcare, and childcare.

You are receiving this email because you qualify for financial assistance through this program based on criteria established by the US Department of Education.

The awards are for students who are enrolled in spring semester classes on March 21, 2022 and meet the eligibility criteria. The amount of the HEERF Grant award is based on the financial aid verified Expected Family Contribution (EFC) for students from the 2021-2022 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and their course credit hour load:

Pell-eligible EFC less than 5847 (verified if selected) attending less than 12 credit hours	\$ 650
Pell-eligible EFC less than 5847 (verified if selected) attending 12 credit hours or more	\$ 900
EFC greater than 5846 or not verified attending less than 12 credits	\$ 400
EFC greater than 5846 or not verified attending 12 credit hours or more	\$ 500
Students unable to complete FAFSA and completed an application	\$ 300

Not all students are eligible. In order to be eligible a student must:

- be registered for credit classes as a regular (not dual enrollment) student as of March 21;
- have completed their 2021-2022 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and have a calculated EFC (Expected Family Contribution) or if unable to complete the FAFSA completed a separate application;
- have completed all financial aid verification items (if required);
- not be a transient student from another college.

While your financial aid file is being used in the calculation of eligibility for CARES/HEERF funds, it is not considered a financial aid award. You may still owe a balance to CPTC for outstanding tuition and fee charges.
