



**AN AGREEMENT TO ESTABLISH A  
TRANSFER ARTICULATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN  
SOUTH GEORGIA STATE COLLEGE, a University System of Georgia institution (USG)  
and  
COASTAL PINES TECHNICAL COLLEGE, a Technical College System of Georgia institution (TCSG)**

Academic Years 2023-2025

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**Introduction**

This agreement formally recognizes that Coastal Pines Technical College and South Georgia State College are active educational partners in providing educational opportunities for currently enrolled and potential students of both institutions.

**Agreement in Principle**

Agreement to this partnership requires a commitment by both institutions to facilitate the transfer of courses from Coastal Pines Technical College, a SACSCOC accredited institution, to South Georgia State College, a SACSCOC accredited institution, for students who want to pursue their Associate or Bachelor degree at South Georgia State College without jeopardizing the intended mission and stated goals of either institution.

This agreement establishes a plan whereby an undergraduate student may first attend Coastal Pines Technical College, an institution accredited by the Commission on Colleges of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools, to work towards a diploma or an associate degree and then transfer to South Georgia State College to complete an associate or bachelor's degree where offered -- on campus in Douglas or Waycross, or online.

**Agreement on Communication**

Coastal Pines Technical College and South Georgia State College agree to cooperate in communicating with each other the articulation relationship between the two institutions. Communications may include common publications and announcements concerning their affiliation. Announcements of this articulation or of changes in the relationship will have a coordinated release to the public from both institutions. The institutions will encourage the dissemination of information about programs in this agreement with interested and qualified students, with both institutions providing advising and counseling to prospective students.

Both parties agree to the following activities to support this partnership:

- South Georgia State College representatives will attend Coastal Pines Technical College events (e.g. open houses, career fairs, and advisement sessions) to present the articulation agreement and associate and bachelor degree options, highlighting outcomes and opportunities associated with bachelor degree achievement.
- South Georgia State College and Coastal Pines Technical College will highlight the value of the articulation agreement by specifying a landing page on respective websites.
- This agreement will be reviewed regularly by both parties to ensure continued ease of transfer for students interested in attending South Georgia State College.

**Agreement on Articulated Courses**

Any Coastal Pines Technical College student who completes coursework towards a diploma or associate degree, is in good standing at Coastal Pines Technical College, and meets the appropriate admissions requirements to attend South Georgia State College will be ensured that the courses earned at Coastal Pines Technical College and listed in this agreement will transfer to South Georgia State College. A minimum grade of C or above will be required for any course designated for transfer of course credit that is not covered in an existing agreement.

Under this agreement, students completing coursework towards a Diploma, an Associate of Science degree, or an Associate of Applied Science degree from Coastal Pines Technical College as outlined in this agreement are eligible to pursue an Associate of Arts degree, an Associate of Science Degree, a Bachelor of Arts degree, or a Bachelor of Science degree from South Georgia State College.

South Georgia State College and Coastal Pines Technical College affirm that both entities will support the efficient and smooth transition of qualified students enrolled in eligible associate or bachelor's degree programs at South Georgia State College.

#### Agreement on Maintenance and Review

At least one administrative or faculty member will be appointed from each participating college to act as a primary point of contact and agent for this agreement, to speak for the institution, and to communicate details and modifications to respective faculty, advisors, and others with interest at the individual institutions.

Terms of this agreement will be effective the date of signing and remain in effect until such time as program changes at either institution require that it be re-articulated. Both parties agree to review this document annually. The agreement may be terminated at the option of either institution following written notification of no less than six (6) months, with the effective date to be the last day of the following semester.

#### **Acceptance of Transfer Credits at South Georgia State College**

The following guidelines are used to award transfer credit toward a degree at South Georgia State College:

- Coursework identified in this agreement that is not covered in an existing transfer agreement will be granted credit only if the coursework received a grade of C or above.
- A minimum of 25% of credits required for the program enrolled must be earned at South Georgia State College to be eligible for graduation.
- Completion of coursework towards a diploma, an associate of science degree, or an associate of applied science degree program at Coastal Pines Technical College does not guarantee admission to South Georgia State College. Candidates must successfully meet all requirements for admission to South Georgia State College.

#### **South Georgia State College Agreement Assurances**

- **Faculty qualifications** – All courses will be taught by highly-qualified faculty, as outlined by the South Georgia State College Faculty Handbook.
- **Outcome assessment** – Cumulative grade point averages are computed using a quality point system. The interpretation of the letter grades and their quality point values is as follows:

<b>Grade</b>	<b>Interpretation</b>	<b>Quality Points Per Credit Hour</b>
A	Excellent	4.0
B	Good	3.0
C	Average	2.0
D	Poor	1.0

In addition, the Colleges assess their programs through a campus-wide Assessment system to support accreditation by the Southern Association of College and Schools.

- **Grievance procedures** – If a student disagrees with an assigned course grade, the student is required to initiate an appeal in accordance with published procedures of each respective institution.
- **Conditions for renewal or termination** – This agreement will be reviewed on an annual basis, with the agreement of both parties. Either party may make adjustments to the course equivalencies or choose not to renew the articulation agreement.




This agreement is in effect and valid starting with the date of the signatures of both Presidents and will remain in effect until terminated in writing by either institution.




